## **Crankworx Colorado**

July 31, 2011

### **Overview:**

The 2011 Crankworx Colorado Downhill is a Category 1 UCI DH event. This Technical Guide covers the procedures for the Pro Men's and Pro Women's Race (Cat 1, 2, 3 included herein) scheduled July 31, 2011.

### **Downhill Race Description:**

The Crankworx Colorado Downhill course requires a combination of technical bike handling skills and fitness. Starting at over 10,600 feet the course covers 1000 vertical feet when it finishes at top of the Gemini lift in Trestle Bike Park at Winter Park Resort. The course was constructed in 2009 for the Crankworx Colorado event by Gravity Logic.

Course length: +/- 1.6 miles

### **Event Information:**

Beginning June 15, 2011, the most up-to-date athlete and team manager information will be posted online at [www.crankworx.com](http://www.crankworx.com). The site will be updated when there are changes to the event information.

### **Event Rules/Licenses:**

Crankworx Colorado shall offer two UCI categories; Elite Men and Elite Women. UCI Regulations shall be enforced for both Elite fields and the UCI Scale of Penalties shall apply.

Valid UCI licenses are required for both the Elite Men and Women. Holders of UCI licenses that do not bear a photograph will be required to present an approved and valid government photo ID in addition to their UCI license.

### **Entry Procedures/Limitations:**

Registration must be completed online prior to July 26 at midnight (MDT) or on-site prior to 9:00am Friday July 29, 2011. See [www.crankworx.com](http://www.crankworx.com) for more details. Starting June 15, the Elite entry fee will be available online at [www.crankworx.com](http://www.crankworx.com) for both men and women.

Final Rider/start lists will be available 12:15pm Friday July 29, 2011

### **Athlete Packet Pick-up:**

On-site Packet Pick-up begins Thursday July 28 at 12:00pm at Crankworx Colorado Headquarters at the base of Winter Park Resort. Racers will be required to present their UCI license and proper identification to pick-up their race plates. NO packet pick-up will be available after Friday July 29 at 11am. Start lists will be available beginning Friday at 1pm.

**Training Period(s):**

Racers must display their race number during training and inspection.

Open training and inspection – when course is open to the public

- July 27 – July 30 – normal operating hours (with the exception of below)

July 29\* – Official on-foot inspection – 1pm-3pm; Official Section Training 3pm-5pm

July 30\* – Official course training and inspection – 11am-1pm

July 31 – Pre-race inspection optional

\*It is a UCI requirement that each athlete/participant complete a minimum of two training runs during official training periods.

**Elite Athlete/Team Managers Meeting:**

The meeting is scheduled for Saturday July 30 at 10am – the Plaza in front of Crankworx Colorado Headquarters.

**July 31: Race-day Schedule**

8am - Lift Opens to racers

8:15am – 9:45am – Elite/Pro and Amateur Class DH course inspection

10:15am – Elite/Pro DH qualifying

12pm – Amateur Class DH Finals

1:30pm – Elite/Pro DH Finals - Top 50 Men and top 15 Women

**Start Area/Rider Call-ups:**

The start line for the downhill race is located at the top of Trestle Bike Park near the Sunspot Restaurant at the top of the Zephyr and Eskimo lifts. All racers will be staged approximately fifteen minutes prior to start time. Preliminary start list will be available at the Athlete/Team Manager meeting.

**Results:**

Professional category racers will be awarded UCI Class 1 points based upon their race finish. Results will be submitted to the UCI 1 hour of the race finish on Sunday.

Preliminary results will be posted in Crankworx Colorado Headquarters. Upon final approval from the UCI Chief all results will be final and posted in Crankworx Colorado Headquarters.

**Podium and Top Finishers:**

The top 3 Pro Men and Pro Women MUST report immediately to the main Awards Stage located in the venue. Failure to report in a timely fashion will result in forfeiture of any and all prize money.

**USADA Anti-Doping:**

USADA doping control facilities will be available if required.
